

Honors Course Contract


The Honors by Contract (HBC) Model allows a student to receive Honors credit for a traditional course when the student and professor agree to course enhancement through project(s) that raise the demands placed on the student to the Honors level as described in the HGTC Honors Program Faculty Guide. The enhancements proposed should bring added depth to the students' understanding and appreciation of topics introduced in, or substantively linked to, the traditional course in which the student is enrolled. The HBC option provides an opportunity for independent learning and directed research.
