Accessibility Problems

- no way to add alternative text descriptions to images.
- no way to add headers to rows and columns for data tables.
- bulleted/numbered lists with more than one level are coded incorrectly.

Accessibility Features

 headings feature is readable by screen readers and carry over when exporting the document to other file formats.
