Narrated Presentations

Summary

Narrated presentations refers to any presentation media that has voiceover and moves through frames or slides as opposed to moving pictures. Some narrated presentations, like Prezi and MS PowerPoint, may also integrate video within the presentation.

Accessibility Problems

Nearly all, if not all, common presentation applications that have narration are not fully accessible because there is no way to add captioning for audio, alternative text tags to images, and certain text may not be usable with screen readers.

Accessibility Features

Nearly all, if not all, common presentation applications that have narration must be converted to a recorded video using a screen recorder, which can then be processed for accessibility. See the "Video" section of the ADA Resource page for more.
