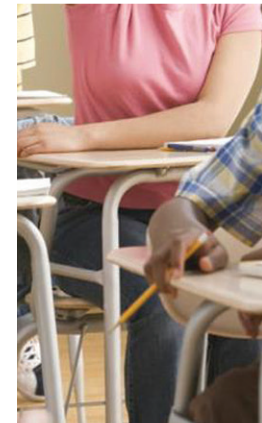
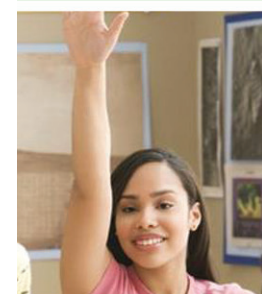

Steps to Completing the PACE Application Packet

Step 1

Complete the Dual Enrollment Application for Admission Form.

Step 2

Complete the FAFSA Waiver Form.
(To be eligible for Lottery Tuition Assistance)

Step 3

Submit copies of ACT, SAT, or COMPASS Test scores to guidance.

Step 4

Return signed and completed application for admission AND FAFSA Waiver Form to your high school guidance counselor.

NOTE: To ensure your PACE Application is processed in a timely manner the following items must be completed. Incomplete applications cannot be processed.

Dual Enrollment Application Form Requires The Following:

- Student's Social Security Number
- Check U.S. Citizen Status
- Check the S.C. Legal Resident Status

List the Date the SC Legal Residency Began:

For example, if a student is a SC resident since birth, list the student's birthdate. If not, list the date the student moved to SC.

• Copies of ACT or SAT Scores Submitted to Guidance and Listed on the Application

If ACT or SAT scores are not available, students are to schedule the COMPASS Test at the HGTC Testing Center or at their school if available. Go to www.hgtc.edu/PACE and Placement Testing: "How to Register for the COMPASS Test" and access "COMPASS Practice Tests."

• Required Signatures:

Parent/Guardian, Student and High School Counselor

• FAFSA Waiver Form Required

Check Only... "I am a high school student enrolled in a dual enrollment program."

Student's social security number (or HGTC H-number if previously enrolled in PACE), address, phone number, signature, and date required.

Incomplete PACE Application Packets

Incomplete PACE Application packets without high school signatures, parent/guardian or student signatures, social security number, test scores, or FAFSA Waiver Form cannot be processed and will result in delayed admissions, non-admissions, or loss of preferred classes.

Lottery Tuition Assistance Available for PACE Dual Enrollment Students

• Any tuition and textbook costs not paid for by the school district are the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian. The school district's dual enrollment policy determines if the course's tuition and textbook costs are the responsibility of the student as outlined in the district's dual enrollment guidelines.

• Lottery Tuition Assistance (LTA) is available for PACE Dual Enrollment High School Students and can be applied towards tuition at HGTC paying over half of tuition costs. To qualify, high school students must be a SC resident for at least a year, enrolled in two PACE classes (6 credit hours) in a semester, and a FAFSA Waiver Form is submitted with the PACE Application. LTA is NOT based on financial need.

• Parents/Guardians will receive a bill and must pay the balance of the tuition upon receipt of the bill after the first week of classes for each semester the student is enrolled in PACE college courses.
