

2013-2014 Verification Worksheet

Your 2013–2014 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, we may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your school. Your school may ask for additional information. If you do not comply with verification, you forfeit student aid eligibility. Submit all documents within 14 days of receipt of the verification notice. The deadline to submit verification is 30 days after your last date of enrollment. If you have questions about verification, contact your financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

The Priority date is the date that the Financial Aid Office will guarantee review of your verification documentation before the semester's payment deadline. **IMPORTANT:** If you submit the required documentation after the scheduled semester priority date, please be prepared to pay your tuition, fees, books and supplies. Once your verification process is completed, you may be reimbursed any eligible financial aid.
