ur 2014 Summer Award, (if any), will be based on your eligibility and attendance for the 2013-14 Academic Year. You must nplete a 2013-14 Free Application for Federal Student Aid, (FAFSA), if you have not already done so.
 Pell: If you were awarded the Federal Pell Grant for the 2013-14 Academic Year and attended less than Full-Time for the Fall Semester and/or Spring Semesters, you may have Federal Pell Grant funds remaining to use for the Summer Semester tuition. Loans: Effective as of July 1, 2013, for all FIRST TIME borrowers: There is a limit on the maximum period of time, (measured in academic years), that you can receive Direct Subsidized Loans. In general, you may not receive Direct Subsidized Loans for more than 150% of the published length of your program. Eligibility for student loans will be determined by the Financial Aid Office. If you have not received the maximum loan amounts of your annual limits during the 2013-14 Award Year, then you may be eligible for a summer student loan. Students enrolled in a Certificate or Diploma program can only be awarded student loans up to the annual loan amounts allowable at the freshman level. Only students enrolled in an Associate's degree program that have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours of coursework required for that program can be awarded student loans up to the annual loan amounts allowable at the Sophomore level. If you are interested in receiving a Summer Loan, and will be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours, please enter the amount you wish to borrow. You MUST enter a requested dollar (\$) amount. The Financial Aid Office will determine your eligibility (if any) up to this amount and award your loan accordingly.
