HIS 101 Western Civilization to 1689 3-0-3

This university parallel transfer course is a study of western civilization from ancient times to 1689, including the major political, social, economic, and intellectual factors shaping western cultural tradition.

HIS 102 Western Civilization Post 1689 3-0-3

This university parallel transfer course is a study of western civilization from 1689 to the present, including major political, social, economic, and intellectual factors which shape the modern western world.

HIS 201 American History: Disc to 1877 3-0-3

This university parallel transfer course is a survey of U.S. history from discovery to 1877. This course includes political, social, economic, and intellectual developments during this period.

HIS 202 American History: 1877 to Pres 3-0-3

This university parallel transfer course is a survey of U.S. history from 1877 to the present. This course includes political, social, economic, and intellectual developments during this period.

HIS 214 History Study Abroad 3-0-3

This course provides a study abroad experience for students studying history. The course includes travel to selected regions outside the United States and provides a field study of historical and contemporary history.

HIS 220 American Studies I 3-0-3

This course is an interdisciplinary study of selected topics and eras in U.S. history.

HIS 230 The American Civil War 3-0-3

This course explores the history of the civil war from the election of 1860 through the end of reconstruction in 1877.
