

**PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT
ADMISSIONS SCORING CRITERIA**

A prospective PTA student may earn a total of 16 points for admission through either Point Option A or Point Option B. Students must have a minimum GPA of at least 2.75 on the PTA Prerequisite courses* and have taken the TEAS test to apply. Students will be awarded entry based on the Option that yields the most points.
