How to Access MHGTC

From a **computer**, visit www.hgtc.edu and click on the myHGTC logo in the upper right corner.

From a **mobile device**, visit www.hgtc.edu, click on the 3 lines in the upper right corner to open the Menu, and click on the myHGTC logo.

Log into myHGTC using your "@hgtc.edu" email address and the password you created.

First Time Logging In?

When logging into myHGTC for the first time, use a computer or a mobile device that is different from your phone. Your phone will be needed separately in a different part of the setup process.

- 1 Use the "@hgtc.edu" email address and default password format provided in the acceptance letter that was mailed to you. Don't have your letter? Call the Technology Solutions Service Desk at 843-349-8324 for help.
- 2 You will be prompted to change your password. Your new password must meet the following requirements:
 - **a.** Must be at least 8 characters
 - **b.** Must include an upper-case letter, a lower-case letter, a number, and a symbol
 - c. Cannot use your first name or your last name as part of the password
 - **d.** Cannot use HGTC as part of the password
 - e. Cannot use a previous password
- 3 You must set up 2 methods of multifactor authentication. You will be locked out of your account if you skip this setup. Unable to set up either of these methods? Call the Technology Solutions Service Desk at 843-349-8324.
 - a. Microsoft Authenticator Setup
 - Using your phone, download the Microsoft Authenticator app from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
 - **II.** Follow the prompts to allow notifications.
 - III. Select the option to Scan a QR Code and allow access to your camera.
 - IV. Click "Next" on the computer until you see the QR code and scan it with your phone.
 - **V.** When you see your "@hgtc.edu" email address in the app, click "Next" on the computer. Enter the code displayed on the computer into the app.
 - VI. Click "Next" once the Microsoft Authenticator setup has been confirmed.
 - **b.** Phone Setup
 - 1. Enter your phone number and click "Next" to receive a code via text message.
 - II. Enter the code on the computer and click "Next".
 - **III.** Click "Done" to finalize the set up.
