Each faculty member is personally responsible for the safety of students in his class and lab areas. At a minimum, the following rules should be followed:

- 1. Stress the importance of the care of equipment.
- 2. Stress the proper use of tools and instruments.
- 3. Inspect the equipment before its use to ensure that it is in good working condition, both from an operational and safety standpoint.
- 4. Be sure proper safety equipment is being used where required to include students and faculty being dressed appropriately.
- 5. No food or drinks should be allowed in the labs and work area of the shops.
- 6. Be familiar with location of first aid supplies and procedures to follow in case of an accident.
- 7. Faculty must be present in classrooms or labs at all times when students or guests of the College are present.
- 8. Any accidents requiring medical attention should be reported to the Executive Vice President for Academic and Workforce Development, Vice President for Human Resources and the Vice President for Student Affairs.
