Chairperson

It is the policy of Horry-Georgetown Technical College that students have the right to withdraw from any or all classes. Furthermore, the College maintains that it is the responsibility of the student to withdraw from courses through their College portal account.

Because changes in course loads impact financial aid, veteran's benefits, and other enrollment related financial situations, it is important that students who anticipate withdrawing from a course or courses investigate the impact of the withdrawal with the appropriate college office.

In addition, courses in some academic programs are sequenced and scheduled at specific times during the year. Withdrawal from these courses often lengthens the time required for students to complete an academic program of study. Students are strongly encouraged to discuss the impact of the withdrawal on program time with their academic advisor.
