Residency classification for tuition and fee purposes at Horry-Georgetown Technical College is governed by the South Carolina Code Sections 59-112-10 through 59-112-150.

Guidelines are established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education and administered by the College.

A person incorrectly classified as an in-state or in-county resident is subject to reclassification and payment of all unpaid nonresident fees. If incorrect classification results from false or concealed information, a person may be charged tuition and fees past due and unpaid at the out-of-state or out-of-county rate and may be subject to discipline under the Student Code of Conduct for the South Carolina Technical College System.
