Residency classification for tuition and fee purposes is determined by the admissions staff at the time an applicant submits an admissions application to Horry-Georgetown Technical College in accordance with the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, Sections 59-112-10 to 59-112-150 and institutional policy. Guidelines are established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education and administered by the College.

Applicants or students may request a review of their residency classification by completing the appropriate residency application for review and submitting the requested supporting documentation. All residency applications and forms can be accessed from the College website. The Residency Coordinator completes residency classification reviews and makes decisions in accordance with guidance and regulations given by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education. An appeal of a residency classification decision may be submitted to the Residency Coordinator and would be reviewed by the Registrar.
