Residency classification for tuition and fee purposes is determined by the admissions staff at the time an applicant submits an admissions application to Horry-Georgetown Technical College in accordance with the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, Sections 59-112-10 to 59-112-150 and institutional policy. Guidelines are established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education and administered by the College.

An applicant or student may request a review of his/her residency classification by completing the "Application for Review of Residency Classification" form available on the College website, in Admissions, or the Office of Student Affairs on the Grand Strand or Georgetown campuses and by submitting requested supporting documentation. Residency classification reviews and decisions are made by the Residency Coordinator. An appeal of a residency classification decision may be made to the Residency Review Committee.
