Students at Horry-Georgetown Technical College are expected to conduct themselves in a mature, dignified, and honorable manner. Activities that are in violation of the Student Code for the South Carolina Technical College System and/or detrimental to the College may be cause for disciplinary action. All faculty and administrators have express authority for general supervision of student conduct. Faculty may temporarily dismiss a student from class and should refer the situation to the Vice President for Student Affairs for disciplinary action.

Due process is recognized as essential to proper enforcement of College rules, and accordingly no formal disciplinary action may be imposed on a student by or in the name of the College except in accordance with the provisions for the Student Code of the South Carolina Technical College System.

Each student charged with misconduct that could result in formal disciplinary action shall have and be informed of the right to a fair hearing in accordance with the Student Code for the South Carolina Technical College System.
