Horry-Georgetown Technical College recognizes the need for student clubs, organizations, and/or affiliations to raise funds to underwrite the cost of their respective club's activities and events. Only officially, recognized student organizations at Horry-Georgetown Technical College have the privilege to raise funds on or off campus for this purpose. The Club's Advisor(s), Director of Student Engagement, Vice President for Student Affairs and the College President or his/her designee must be notified and approval sought for any external fundraising activities.

In addition, Horry-Georgetown Technical College recognizes the need for student clubs, organizations, and/or affiliations to solicit donations from businesses and individuals to support their respective club's activities and events. Only officially, recognized student clubs or organizations at Horry-Georgetown Technical College have the privilege to solicit donations on or off campus for this purpose. The Club's Advisor(s), Director of Student Enhancement, vice President of Student Affairs, and the College President or his/her designee must be notified and approval sought prior to any donation solicitation activity.
