Graduates of the Nursing Assistant Certificate for credit and non-credit (workforce development) programs are eligible require 150 hours to include classroom instruction, skills practicum and clinical rotation. These requirements meet the educational requirements for South Carolina, but HGTC's CNA programs have not been approved by the appropriate state licensing boards in any other state.
