

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN/PARAMEDIC

Graduates of HGTC's Emergency Medical Technician and/or the Paramedic program are eligible to sit for the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) examination. To be considered nationally-registered and eligible for licensure in South Carolina graduates must pass appropriate examination(s). In addition to national certification, an individual's state of residence or location may have its own certification examinations, registration and/or licensing requirements. Graduates of HGTC's EMT/Paramedic program are qualified to sit for the national registry examination in South Carolina and Georgia. Please note that GA has a separate state examination that must be passed in addition to the NREMT.
