Residency classification for tuition and fee purposes at Horry-Georgetown Technical College is governed by the South Carolina Code Sections 59-112-10 through 59-112-150.

Guidelines are established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education and administered by the College.

A person incorrectly classified as an in-state or in-county resident is subject to reclassification and payment of all unpaid nonresident fees. If incorrect classification results from false or concealed information, a person may be charged tuition and fees past due and unpaid at the out-of-state or out-of-county rate and may be subject to discipline under the Student Code of Conduct for the South Carolina Technical College System. Until these charges are paid, such person will not be allowed to receive transcripts from Horry-Georgetown Technical College.
